Admission Meeting

At your son/daughter's admission meeting a plan will be drafted with you to establish how best to provide an appropriate curriculum, with opportunities for exam entries, work experience and careers advice for your son/daughter.



Education Programmes

Pupils should attend in accordance with their agreed timetable – the expectation is that they will follow the timetabled programme.



Pupils will receive as far as possible a balanced and relevant curriculum. Emphasis is placed upon the core subjects (Maths, English I.C.T. and PSHE.) Careers Advice, Art, Music, Science, DT and a range of other subjects and vocational courses are also offered if appropriate.

Pupils will be expected to continue their educational programme at home by completing homework tasks. This is an important part of their educational plan.

We offer our students a transition to regular study patterns and preparation for reintegration to Further Education, training or employment.

Communication

Reports will be sent to parents and other appropriate educational establishments either as the student leaves, or at the end of an academic year. Parents\Carers will have the opportunity to talk to staff about their child's progress at parents' evenings and we will call you at least every 2 weeks to discuss your son/daughter's progress.



Lunch and Breaks

A tuck shop which sells healthy snacks is available at break times – not at lunchtimes. Students who are present over lunchtime can either:

- Bring a packed lunch
- Purchase a packed lunch from a menu provided at the Pupil Referral Unit.
- Yr 10 / 11 students may leave site during break times with parental consent

After the Admission Meeting

At your son/daughter's admission meeting a date will be set for Induction. This will involve:

- A short attendance for an induction session.
- Assessment of your son/daughter's needs and the setting of a timetable
- Arranging of transport (this takes up to 5 days)
- You will be sent a copy of your son/daughter's timetable and informed of the transport arrangements and start date
