

Sevenside Education Centre Reintegration Pupils

Pupils are admitted to the reintegration programme when they have been excluded from school.

Each pupil's programme starts with an Admissions Meeting. During this meeting, the pupil's individual needs, parents' views and the objectives of the Centre are discussed and a Home



School Agreement is signed. Pupils should come dressed in school uniform and expect to fully attend their arranged programme. If the pupil is eligible for transport, it will be arranged for their return home on day one and then daily as per the timetable.

Education Programmes

Pupils receive as far as possible a balanced and relevant curriculum. Emphasis is placed upon the core subjects (Maths, English I.C.T. and PSHE.).

Pupils are expected to complete homework, which is an important part of their Individual Education Plan. Pupils are supported in setting and reaching personalised targets relating to both academic and social/behavioural progress.

We offer our pupils preparation for reintegration to school, and colleagues from the Behaviour Support Team monitor pupils' progress after their return to school.

Communication

Reports are sent to parents/carers, schools and other partners when the pupil leaves.

Parents\Carers and school are contacted regularly by the tutor to discuss progress.



Lunch and Breaks

Pupils are not allowed offsite during any break time. We are a healthy eating school and we therefore ask parents/carers to support us in not including fizzy drinks, chocolate or sweets in packed lunches.

Pupils can either:

- Bring a packed lunch
- Purchase a packed lunch from a menu provided at the unit, priced at £1.75.
